WINNERS (IN RED BELOW) AND WILDCARDS ARE NOW QUALIFIED FOR OUR BEST OF THE YEAR GALA IN GREEN BAY WISCONSIN, ON A YET TO BE DETERMINED DATE IN SEPTEMBER 2022 (IT WILL BE KNOWN AROUND MID MAY). THE MEGA EVENT WILL ALSO BE EMCEED BY FREDDY MOYANO, OUR PRESIDENT AND AWARD-WINNING FILMMAKER, PRODUCER, ACTOR. WE HAVE SEEN WILDCARDS COME BACK TO WIN BEST OF THE YEAR. WINNERS AND WILDCARDS BOTH GET A WIN ON IMDB. 


